Report of the Executive Board

The Board of Directors met once in the past business year. There was also one general meeting.

Particularly worthy of mention from the past business year are:

- On 20 and 21 June we had a small stand at the Market of Opportunities at the Kirchentag in Dortmund as part of the WAW
- Since 01.08. the office is in Eichenstr. 6, 76703 Kraichtal (Menzingen)
- On 12.11. we applied for full membership of the WAW.
- From 05.12.-29.12. the trip was to Abedju / DR Congo. The company ACBE from Aru / DR Congo had been commissioned to carry out a geophysical survey to determine the best drilling site, to drill a 7-inch well and to carry out a 48-hour pumping test.

None of the work was done professionally so the well was not usable. The estimate was \$9667. We paid nothing. The project was suspended on 21/12 until further notice. There was a joint meeting of members of the hospital, church and IWFA

From 19 to 21.12 we were in Adja to remeasure two points, take some photos, and make films including an interview.

Members: The number of members on 31.12.2019 was ten.



Project Abedju / Democratic Republic of the Congo

From 4 to 29 December, we were in the project at the mission hospital in Abedju. The hospital management had found a Congolese drilling company that was willing to drill in Abedju. Beforehand, we discussed and agreed in writing with this company on the minimum technical requirements for the hydrogeological investigation and the drilling.

When we arrived in Abedju, the subcontractor in charge of the hydrogeological survey did not comply.

The drilling company arrived on site six days late. After a short time, it became apparent that the drilling equipment was not professional. There were repeated interruptions because the bits and the rods were causing problems.

On the third day of work, we stopped the work because the company was not able to install filter pipes. Without prior consultation, they had changed to a smaller diameter. This was too small for the filter pipes.

That same evening we called a meeting with the hospital management, the church management and the boss of the drilling company. There it was decided that the project would be stopped at this point and the drilling company would not be paid. They had knowingly not complied with the requirements agreed in writing. The head of the company admitted that he knew when the contract was signed that they could not meet the minimum technical requirements. They tried; it worked for other organisations. However, at those no one stood there and checked the work.

The project will continue as soon as a competent drilling company is found.
