Water Supply Missionary Hospital Abedju and Adja, DR. Kongo



We will travel to Abedju, Ituri region, in the Democratic Republic of Congo, from December 5 to 29. The trip was for November planned. It was delayed because three Ugandan drilling companies cancelled. Two companies it is in the region Ituri too insecure - riots, Ebola and war on

the border of the South Sudan in about 20km distance. The third drilling company did not meet the requirements. Now the hospital staff has found a Congolese drilling company that is willing to carry out the geophysical survey, the drilling and the pump

test. The cost estimate for this is US\$9,667. The amount has already been donated. The solar pump with solar system, lightning protection, transport over 700 km, pressure pipe and Installation costs about 14,000 euros. More exact costs will only



be known after the trip, when the depth of the pump in the borehole is known. Once this work has been completed, the same company will also carry out a geophysical survey at the missionary hospital in Adja in preparation for subsequent drilling. The cost estimate for this is US\$1,300. The amount has

already been donated.

Approximately 8,000 Euros are needed for the drilling work next year. The solar pump with solar system, lightning protection, transport over 750 km and installation costs about 15.000 Euro. More details costs are only fixed after the trip, when the location of the borehole etc. has been determined.



Our passports are currently still in the embassy of the Democratic Republic of Congo in Berlin. Since our invitation letter was issued for November and December, our visa will also only be valid until December.

Therefore the further work will be done in spring 2020. New visas will be required.
